Constructive Criticism: Constructive criticism is a helpful way of giving feedback that provides specific, actionable suggestions. Rather than providing general advice, constructive criticism gives specific recommendations on how to make positive improvements.

- 1. Look through your partner's planning sheet (questions, not sketches) and compare their artwork with what they planned to do.**
- 2. Some things to consider are:**
 - a. Can you see their color scheme?**
 - b. Can you tell how they are creating space in their art?**
 - c. Can you see the principles of design that they chose to emphasize?**
- 3. Give at least one positive comment**
- 4. Give at least one example of how to improve or adjust as they continue to work**
